

EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

MONITORING EXERCISE 2018



The ELT Council notifies persons who are qualified and experienced in the ELT industry to submit their Expression of Interest in participating in a monitoring exercise of a number of licenced ELT schools and annexes in Malta and Gozo in summer 2018.

Successful candidates will be expected to:

1. Attend mandatory training sessions in relation to duties to be performed;
2. conduct complete monitoring visits in a number of licensed schools and annexes between July and September 2018;
3. observe and evaluate lessons from an academic perspective;
4. submit all duly signed individual school/annexe reports to the ELT Council;
4. and prepare an overall report which should include specific recommendations for all schools and annexes.

By the closing time and date of this Expression of Interest, applicants must possess:

- a minimum of 5 years academic experience in the ELT sector;
- an internationally-recognised Level 7 qualification in ELT (e.g. Master's in TESOL/ELT/TEFL; Cambridge ESOL DELTA, or Trinity College Dip. TESOL);
- previous experience as a classroom observer or teacher trainer or experience in quality assurance duties in educational environments;
- excellent writing skills in the English language.

Selected candidates will not have been involved with any ELT School for the previous 6 months.

Interested persons are to submit an application by not later than noon (12.00 CET) of Friday 8 June **2018**, a CV pertinent to the role, and a 100-word paragraph stating why they consider themselves eligible to take on this assignment. Applications should be sent to:
