

## English Language Teaching Council Sponsors Teacher Training Programme

The English Language Teaching Council has sponsored an in-service training programme for state school teachers. The programme aimed to assist teachers with their professional development by providing them with the opportunity to attend sessions on teaching English in secondary school induction classes.
